We kind of went along with this situation as we did not know what to do.

Last year we decided to go on a camping trip to Tasmania. Our biggest concern was the boat trip, where pets and people are separated for 12 hours minimum. This is when I contacted Helen. I deeply regret that I hadn't contacted her earlier on when these problems started. Helen has changed our life's forever. Not only has Helen addressed Lillis fear issue, she has also looked into her problems with the epileptic seizures.

Helen has worked with us together so wonderfully. Now Lilli happily goes for walks on cloudy days and hasn't had an epileptic seizure for 5 months. Lilli is the very happy dog she used to be and even our Vet noticed how healthy and happy she is. We can highly, highly recommend Helen.
