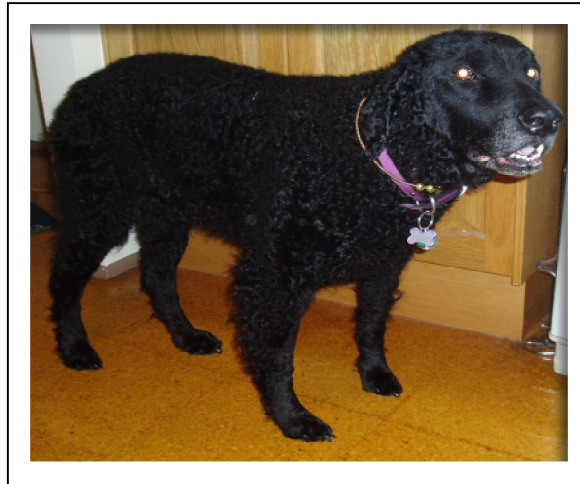


“Lillie” – a case of chronic shoulder injury



My Curly Coated Retriever, Lillie, injured her shoulder a couple of years ago then her hip last year. As a result there has been deterioration in the muscle and in both joints and the onset of arthritis. She has been receiving ongoing treatment using Bowen Therapy, tissue salts, homeopathies, laser, cartrophan injections and energy coils. These treatments have been successful at keeping her comfortable and as a result she only has a slight limp and nothing stops her when she is going for her walk.

One Friday I arrived home to find her hardly able to walk or turn her head to the left. I gave her a Traumeel tablet for the pain and attempted to use the energy coils on her. She did not want the coil anywhere near her and kept moving away from me. She was whimpering every time that she tried to lie down and could not get comfortable. After two hours she was still in a lot of pain so I rang Helen.

As usual, Helen saved my sanity. She told me to give her a “hot seven”. This involved dissolving 7 magnesium phosphate tablets (no 7 in tissue salts) and three Traumeel homeopathic tablets in 20mls of hot water. I then gave her a little of this every 10 minutes over the next two hours.

The morning came and I was greeted by a bright eyed Lillie who then proceeded to chase my other dog Noah through the house like nothing had ever happened. She then took me on a 1 hour walk with hardly a limp the whole way.
