

On the 10th December 2010, my dog Riley all of a sudden was very wobbly on his hind legs and then very quickly he had no movement at all, it was if he was completely paralysed from the waist down. I rushed to my vet and then to the specialist hospital to have Riley diagnosed with Invertebral Disc Disease -he was hospitalised and on morphine & cortisone with the surgical team recommending spinal surgery at a cost of \$8,000 plus \$2000for MRI and other scans.

The only way Riley could walk was to put a towel under him and lift his back legs off the ground to allow him to move around on his front legs. He would not eat and was depressed. I could not afford the surgery therefore the only option was to proceed with complete rest and cortisone treatment.

After a week, Riley was no better. My vet suggested continued care at home but believed his prognosis was not good. Riley cold not use his back legs to walk and was also incontinent. I was desperate to help my dog and my cousin told me to try Bowen Therapy and after some phone calls came across Helen.
